

Paper Shredding Event 2011

“The Manasquan Environmental Commission with great support from Fran Metzger of Monmouth County held a document shredding event on Sunday, September 18 at the 4th Avenue parking lot. Dozens of residents of the Borough participated and we shredded over 4.5 tons of documents. The town gets two benefits from this activity. First, the 4.5 tons of paper never enters the town garbage stream and Manasquan avoids fees on this un-necessary tonnage. Second, the shredded documents are recycled and the town receives financial credit for this recycled tonnage. Additionally the Borough filled a large truck with cardboard for recycling eliminating this cardboard from the garbage stream.

Borough residents also donated 116 pounds of food to the Monmouth Ocean County Food Bank to help families in need during these difficult economic times.
